2. Based on this passage, define "repentance." According to John the Baptist, what was the Pharisees' and Sadducees' problem?
3. Why did Jesus need to be baptized?
4. In Matthew 17, God the Father's voice also comes out of heaven to commend Jesus. After reading Deuteronomy 18:15, describe how Jesus's baptism and his transfiguration are similar. How are they different?
5. In what specific ways can we act like John the Baptist today, preparing the way for the Lord to enter the lives of family, friends, and co-workers? In what ways can we remind ourselves and other believers that Christ is King?
