Matthew 6

1. Jesus gives many specific instructions in Matthew 6:1-7. Describe in your own words the things he tells us to do as well as the things we are not to do.
2. What common theme do you see in Christ's teaching on giving, prayer, and fasting? Do you see patterns in your life in these areas that resemble the Pharisees'? Consider these and spend time confessing them to the Lord.
3. List some of the earthly treasures that the Lord has blessed you with. Next to each one describe what you invest in it. (i.e. time, money, talking about, worrying about). Do these treasures point your heart to or away from Christ?
