Discussion Questions

Joshua 15-17

1. In Joshua 15:13-16, how does Caleb involve others in conquering Debir? Why do you think he chose to include others when he had just conquered Hebron on his own? How does God do the same when He chooses to include Christians in the work He could do himself? (See Romans 12:6-8, 1 Peter 4:10-11.)
2. How does the attitude of the people of Joseph in Joshua 17:14 differ from the attitude of Caleb in Joshua 14:6-12? How does Joshua respond to the people of Joseph? How do you see the attitude of the people of Joseph present in our world today? How do you see it present in your own heart?
3. What obstacles do the people of Joseph point to in 17:14-16 as preventing them from conquering the plain? What obstacles do you allow to prevent you from doing God's will or receiving His blessings? What are some specific things you could do to overcome these obstacles?
4. After reading Ephesians 1:11-14 and Hebrews 9:15, describe your inheritance in Christ. How is this inheritance different than any other inheritance we may receive? What aspect of your inheritance do you prize the most?
5. After studying chapters 15-17, what specific truths have you learned about God's promises and providence?
