Discussion Questions

Joshua 21-22

1. Chapter 21 discusses the land that the Lord gives to the Levites. After re-reading Joshua 14:3-4, describe how does their allotment of land differs from the other tribes' allotments. What do Deuteronomy 10:6-9 and Numbers 35:1-8 tell us about why the Levites' inheritance is different from that of the other tribes?
2. In Joshua 21:44 and again in 22:4 the author talks about *rest*. What does rest mean in this context? What does rest look like in your own life? In what ways can you see the Lord offering you rest? How well do you take advantage of opportunities to rest?
3. Reread Joshua 22:4-6. What charge does Joshua give to the tribes? Does that charge apply to us today? How?
4. Re-read vs. 10-34. Why do the eastern tribes build an altar to the Lord? For what reason do the western tribes think they also built the altar? How is the conflict resolved?
5. Has there ever been a time in your life where your motives have been misunderstood or where you have misunderstood someone else's motives? What can this passage teach you about your assumptions about or attitudes toward others?
