1 Timothy 6:3-20

1. Looking through the whole passage, which godly traits does this passage emphasize? Circle the one(s) God has been working into your heart and life recently.
2. In verses 5-10, Paul refers to a false teaching that equates godliness with material wealth. According to verses 6-8, how are we to find contentment?
3. In your own words, summarize Paul's teaching on riches in verses 9-10 and 17-19.
4. List the characteristics of God described in verses 13-16. How can these qualities comfort you and bolster your faith when you are faced with adversity?
5. In verse 20, Paul reminds Timothy to "guard the deposit entrusted to you. Avoid irreverent babble and contradictions of what is falsely called knowledge." In what specific ways do you safeguard the truth of the gospel in your own life?
