Titus 3

1. After reading Titus 3, what did you learn about “deeds” or “works” of righteousness? Why should we do them?
2. In verses 3-7, Paul describes how God's grace changed him. List the “progression” of these changes. What part do God's mercy and grace play in the transformation Paul describes?
3. After reading verses 3-7, describe how have you've seen God's mercy and grace in your life?
4. In verse 9, Paul warns believers about things that might distract or entangle them. What are they? As you consider your own life, what “foolish” things do you see that distract you from whole-hearted devotion to God?
5. Read Ephesians 2:8-10 and Titus 3:8. List specific good works that God has called to you to.
6. How has the study of Titus influenced your thoughts on how to live each day? Share with your small group one specific lesson that God has taught you.
