Two Featured Family Resources:

<u>Indescribable by Louie Giglio</u> is a family devotion book that would work well with children ages 6-10. Each devotion features a "Be Amazed" section with fascinating facts, hands-on activities, and a closing prayer. This book focuses on God as our Creator and connecting science with God. There are a few families using this devotion book right now and love it!

The Radical Book for Kids by Champ Thornton is a book ideal for older elementary children, ages 8-14. This is a book that can be used as individual reading for kids or for parents to read with their children before bed. Some of the chapters include "Can you prove that God exists?" and "How we know the Bible is true". Each chapter is connected to scripture and intended to make readers fall more in love with Jesus and his Word. We have used this book with our two older kids and plan to encourage Nolan to start it!
